

Mission Guinea Support Update

January 2022

Happy New Year from the Mission Guinea Working group and many thanks for your ongoing support of this important work.

Since our previous update, the Mission Guinea working group has met twice (8th October 2021 and 14th January 2022).

The following is a report of major happenings and an update of support. We have included the latest statement of income and expenditure and at the end of the report you will find a selection of reports that have been sent through to us by our brethren in Guinea and Liberia.

Baptisms – keep our new family members in your prayers

There have been a number of baptisms of late in both Guinea and Liberia.

Pig project – keep in prayers, consider supporting

The pig project is going from strength to strength with four congregations in the forest region (in and around N'zerekore) now having pigs; Samoe, Bellevue, Laine and Sokoura.

This all started in Samoe with three adult pigs. Recently the pigs in Samoe gave birth to 9 piglets and the pigs in Bellevue to 11 piglets. This has enabled the piglets to be shared with other congregations for increased production. A time will soon come when these pigs can be sold to make this project self-sufficient. However, in the meantime, the brethren have requested support to help in the provision of food and medicine for the pigs. Please consider if you can help support in this way.

Extract from a request from Sam Williams (Samoe – 12th January 2022)

'We deem it necessary to ask for help to procure food and medication for the children's pig because the price of the pig food has gone up to 400% increase of the normal price we have been buying it. The 100 kg bag we were buying for 60,000fg before is now 250,000fg and we thank God that the project is progressing.'

II. Physical activities: the congregation continue to maintain the pigs in the pigsty initiated by Guinea Mission. The sow farrowed and gave ten piglets but nine are alive. We have now a total of eleven pigs in the pigsty. To God be the praise and the initiator of such project. The problem is that it takes more than 80% of our collect every month (treatment and feeding).

Radio programs – a successful evangelism tool in West Africa

Radio is used as a form of evangelism by three of the congregations that are supported through Mission Guinea, namely Voinjama (Liberia), Sokoura and Conakry.

The Sokoura radio program is currently on every Sunday morning from 7:45 to 8:45am. Plans are underway to change this to a 30-minute time slot on Sunday mornings with the addition of an hour time slot on Wednesday evenings.

Extract from Sokoura report (27th August 2021)

The Radio programme: We Give Praise to God for this important part of the work in our community. Through this the Lord's Church is known and people are edified. About six years we are making known the will of God to the people of N'zérékoré thanks to the financial support of the American brothers in Niceville. Our teaching now is, "**You can just become a Christian?**" Let us all pray together because there is a listener from a neighboring village of N'Zérékoré who requests to establish a branch of the church in his village through the teaching he hears from the radio programme, so we are working on that.

The Conakry radio program is on Radio Familia (FM105.3) every Tuesday night from 9 to 9:30pm. The Voinjama radio program is on Voice of Lofa, 99.3FM every Sunday @8:00-9:30pm and on Radio Kintoma 101.1FM every Thursday 5:00-6:00pm. How much do things cost in Guinea?

Have you ever wondered how much a bag of rice or a kilogram of onions costs in Guinea? We have pulled together the costs of a few items that have recently been bought with the support provided through Mission Guinea. As you can see, the cost of living in Guinea is not cheap. This has been exacerbated by border closures and supply shortages.

1 bag of rice (50 kg)	340,000	52.85
1 pack of toothpaste	25,000	3.89
1 kilogram of onions	15,000	2.33
1 Litre of petrol	11,000	1.71

Just as in Australia and other parts of the world, the current Covid-19 pandemic has resulted in disruption to regular gatherings of the Church in Guinea and Liberia. This has resulted in some struggling with their faith. Please continue to pray for our brethren's spiritual and physical health at this time.

Travel to Guinea - ASAP

As you can appreciate, the restrictions in international travel because of the Covid pandemic, has delayed plans to return to Guinea. Please keep in your prayers plans for a return visit to Guinea and Liberia to:

- Encourage and support brethren,
- Facilitate the construction of phase two and three of the Bible Training College, and
- See how we can best support brethren in ongoing (soap making and pigs) projects and new initiatives.

Lord willing, later in 2022 a return trip to Guinea will be possible.

Support Update

Please refer to the attached statement of Income and Expenditure (Page 7) for detail on Mission Guinea support.

To date, a total of \$133,492 has been provided in support. This is an amazing effort and is helping our brethren greatly.

For the bible school construction, we are now working toward out third phase support target of \$15,000 AUD. This third phase of support is to go toward construction of the second floor of the bible training college. So far, \$10,745.89 of support has been provided toward this goal.



Keep in your prayers

Specific prayer requests that have come from our brethren in Guinea include:

- N'zerekore region – on top of Covid, there has been an Ebola outbreak.
- All of Guinea – a new president was appointed following a military coup in September 2021. Prayers for a stable government and continued peace.
- A full return to worship following Covid restrictions.
- Plans for 2022.
- Bellevue – The planned youth camp in the N'zerekore region has been postponed twice due to Covid. Prayers this can go ahead as an encouraging event for the region.
- Bellevue – plans to complete their new worship hall.
- Sokoura – health of Zeze (the evangelist we support) as he is recovering from Typhoid fever.
- Sokoura – health of the daughter of a member (Donmani Bilirogui) who is very unwell.



We are sure that the implementation of the courses received will help us in our work especially in the growth and multiplication of the church in our locality.

We received \$ 400 dollars to purchase the projector, a tool that will help in public evangelism. We have already ordered it from Conakry because it is not easy to find here in N'Zérékoré and when the order is obtained we will keep you informed.

Regarding the sokoura work funds, we are currently using part of it in the construction work of preachers' and guest host. After the doors confection, we will soon begin plastering and paving and we will report back to you.

Be blessed in this time of pandemic when the world is looking to heal.

It is the best opportunity for me to thank our brethren who are supporting me and the work of our Lord and pray that our God bless them all in Jesus name Amen!


SOKOURA LOCAL CHURCH IN NZEREKORE REGION:

The assembly’s plan to organize the 2021 youth bible camping is still maintained but waiting for the health restrictions imposed by the authorities to be lifted.
Note: the attendance is been poor in the quarter, the reason is that it is vacation time and more people go spend the vacation in the village to prepare next school year.
 - II. **Physical activities:** the congregation continue to maintain the pigs in the pigsty initiated by Guinea Mission. The sow farrowed and gave ten piglets but nine are alive. 6. We continue to look for new students for the 3rd Promotions (2022-2024); there are already (14) people that we have started to prepare on the ground.

DIFFICULTIES:

In GUINEA there is an increase in the prices of basic necessities.

In prisons and health centers and in the regional hospital and assist its prisoners and patients with material means and in the end;

Prison Ministry/baptism:

The Lord added two inmates: brother Tarnuekollie Jarvah and brother Kalilu Boakai.

Brother Kalilu Boakai a Muslim at the prison; this young man baptism was a wonder thing; the authority of the prison delayed his baptism firstly, because a Muslim is the Duty Superintendent and the day of his baptism, there was a heavy down pour of rain. We all got wet. He was so happy and he discussed with us that he was feeling so bad because of the long time it took him to get baptize. We encouraged him that, the Lord Jesus will guide him; and he needs to trust and have faith in Jesus Christ.

At the prison, we are there every Sunday after service to preach/teach the inmates the words of God.

The Church was able through the blessing of our Lord Jesus Christ, intervened and released one of the inmates in person of Tarnue M. Kollie. He and the County Attorney, Luther Sumo had problem on timber issue. Hon. Sumo said that, Tarnue took his wood/timber and sold it. The conclusion was, free the man and let him produce the timber since he is the one sawing for you.

Outreach/Bike usage:

All of the Church activities, the bike have been useful. To get to the two radio stations for the program Back to the Bible Programs, prison ministry, homes visit; this time around, because of these visits, we found one of the sisters who is a member of the Lord Church, sister Damaway Kolu. She is regular and active. The bike is a great help in achieving most of our outreach services and follow up on other church activities. For now, we have less money spend for transportation and timing; we easily get to places and on time if our activities are properly planned. We are so energized by the Guinea Mission Group for this support.

Minister support:

My family and I are very much grateful for the financial support that Mission Guinea Group is providing. As I said, this is my first time to receive such assistance as minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ. We have received a lot of support from Niceville Church of Christ for the Lord's work here, but a direct or specific support to me is welcoming. We are wholeheartedly thankful to God for these supports; it should not only be me but the Lord's work. This is why I am encouraged by the brethren here in Voinjama who strengthen me by God's grace.

We will be having a congregational meeting on the second Sunday in January 2022, to plan and outline activities for 2022. From this meeting, we have précised projects and activities for 2022 to be achieve by God's grace. Bro. Saah John, the work committee chairperson will conduct this said meeting.
